Any degree-seeking student carrying the equivalent of 6 undergraduate semester credit hours or 3 graduate semester credit hours may submit:

**2 TEN-MINUTE PLAYS, 2 ONE-ACT PLAYS,
AND 2 FULL-LENGTH PLAYS**

Please note: One Acts may be entered in the John Cauble Short Play category, but they may also be entered in other Michael Kanin Playwriting Award categories. The John Cauble and Michael Kanin Awards for one-acts go to different e-mail addresses and must be entered separately and accompanied by a cover sheet. Full-length plays must fit into one of the Michael Kanin Playwriting Award categories, except the National Student Playwriting Award and the David Mark Cohen Award. Plays for the National Student Playwriting Award must be entered as a Participating Entry and be invited to the regional festival. Entries for the David Mark Cohen Award must be entered as a Participating or Associate entry.

If your school has had one Participating or Associate entry during the year from December 15th to December 15th, there is **NO SUBMISSION CHARGE**. Otherwise send a check for \$10.00 per entry, made out to ACTF Management, LTD—Region VIII to:
